



BACK OPENING KNOCKER

For Double Point Needles (DPNs)

Material:

- 1 set of 7 – 8 in double point needles (DPNs) size 4 mm
- 100% cotton DK weight Cascade Yarn, Ultra Pima (Regular Knocker)
- 100% acrylic DK weight Sport (AquaKnock)
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

Terminology:

- CO: Cast on
- Kfb: knit into front & back of stitch
- K: knit
- P: purl
- K2tog: knit 2 stitches together
- St: stitch
- Sts: stitches

Start from Back

- With a 20 in tail, loosely CO 15 sts and divide between 3 DPN (5 on each needle)
- Row 1: K to last st, kfb. Repeat for needle 2 & 3; 3 sts increased (18)
- Row 2: kf, k to last st, kfb. Repeat for needle 2 & 3; 6 sts increased (24)
- Repeat rows 1 & 2 until you reach the number of sts for the cup size you desire (see cup chart below)

Edge Rows:

- P 2 rounds (these define the edge between the back and front of knocker)

For Double Point Needles (DPNs)

Front Piece (without nipple):

- Decrease row: K to last 2 sts on each needle, k2tog.
- Repeat this row until you have 6 sts left (2 on each needle)
- Cut yarn leaving an 8 in tail.
- Thread tail through remaining sts with tapestry needle, pull tight.
- Bring to inside of the knocker and fasten off

Front Piece (with nipple):

- Decrease row: K to last 2 sts on each needle, k2tog
- Repeat this row until you have 3 sts left (1 on each needle)
- Knit these 3 sts onto one needle and proceed with I-cord for 3 rounds.
- Cut yarn leaving an 8 in tail.
- Using a tapestry needle, thread tail through remaining sts.
- Stretch and twist I-cord tightly, stitch down to create a small nipple (no more than 3/8 in across)

Finish Back Piece:

- Using tapestry needle, weave CO tail through every other CO stitch. This will make a draw-string closure.

Cup Size:

- A cup: diameter is 4.5 in.....or..... 72 sts
- B cup: diameter is 5 in.....or..... 78 sts
- C cup: diameter is 5.5 insor..... 90 sts
- D cup: diameter is 6 ins or..... 102 sts
- DD/E cup: diameter is 6.5 ins.....or..... 108 sts
- F cup: diameter is 7 ins..... Or..... 114 sts
- G cup: diameter is 7.5 ins..... or..... 120 sts
- H cup: diameter is 8 ins.....or..... 126 sts
